**Ans. Sadguru Nityanand Swami:** On the Magshar sud 8, V.S. 1903, in the presence of Acharya Raghuvirji Maharaj, Gopalanand Swami, Shuk Muni, Shunyatitanandji and many other sadhus, he left his corporeal body at Vartal.
