Just by listening to a few days of this Maanbhatt's recital of the Mahabharat, Dungar picked up the style in which the verses were sung.

- Gateway to Akshardham:** Many devotees doubted the need for such an elaborate Sinhasan considering that there had barely been enough resources to finish the Shikhar itself. (110)
- Birth and Blessings:** Shastriji Maharaj was born in the village of Mahelav on Fagun sud 5, Samvat 1982. (2)
- The Protective Shield of Gunatit:** In Nana Gokharvala, a village in Kathiawad, a devotee by the name of Harmanbhai had a vision of Gunatitanand Swami. (73)
- "I am Yogi and Yogi is Myself":** Swamishri decided to go to Sarangpur for the festival of Jal-Jhilani so that thousands of devotees could have his darshan for the last time. (118)
- Sixty-Eight Places of Pilgrimage:** In Kashi, Khushal Bhagat had darshan of Ganga in the form of a cow. Thus, his ignorance was removed. (95)
- Bond of love between guru and disciple:** Once, while Jnanjivandasji was performing prostrations in Junagadh mandir, one sadhu stabbed him from behind with a large needle and another sadhu threw a drinking pot on him; Jnanjivandasji ran out immediately. (33)
